The South Coast Community Chorale is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization dedicated to spreading the joy of choral music to the greater South Coast community. SCCC began as the dream shared by a group of seven friends in 1997 and has grown into a sixty voice choir. We perform two annual concert programs, one in December and one in May, which highlights classical as well as contemporary music.

Through donations, dues, and fundraisers, SCCC has established the Karen K. Miller Memorial Scholarship. Karen was a dedicated member of SCCC serving as secretary of the Board of Directors and multiple committees including the scholarship committee, before unexpectedly passing in 2016. Because of Karen's passion for education, SCCC will award a scholarship to a student pursuing a degree at an institution of higher education. The scholarship is awarded at one of SCCC's two spring concerts each year.

The concerts are scheduled for May 20, 2023 and May 21, 2023.

Recipients of the scholarship will receive tickets for the concert date of their choice when they receive notification of their award.

Applicants for the scholarship must:

1. Member or family member of SCCC*
2. Be entering or currently enrolled in a degree program at an accredited college or university and provide proof of acceptance (or enrollment)
3. Be a graduating high school senior, undergraduate, or graduate student
4. Be able to use the award during the 2023-2024 academic year
5. Complete the attached scholarship application (Including specified documents and essay)
